



2026-27 Club Membership Policies and Procedures

Hunting Memberships

- **Included in Membership:** Membership dues for the 2026-27 hunting season are \$4,000 and **due by June 15, 2026 (existing members)**. Each paid membership allows *six (6) harvested deer total. 2 Bucks MAXIMUM*. Also included in the membership: unlimited hog hunting, turkey and duck hunting, year-round access to select fishing ponds, and use of Spike's outdoor bar and grilling area and fire-pits (when there is no event booked). **Proper hunting license, bag limits, season dates and point regulations on all game animals shall be in accordance with Georgia State Law, if not superseded by High Pine Hunting Club rules. Please refer to <https://gadnr.org>. Know the law.**
- **Family Members:** A paid membership includes the paying member, spouse, and children through the age of 18. Children of members ages *19 through 24* who are *full time students* or *actively enlisted in the military* shall be included in a parent's membership. ****The aforementioned family members will share the bag limits on game animals.**
- **Guests:** Each paid membership is entitled to a total of three (3) *guest* hunting days, one guest per day - this applies to ALL game. Guest hunting days must be scheduled *in advance* and approved by High Pine management. Guests for deer hunting will only be allowed **after December 1**. ***Guest hunters will share the member's allotted bag limits** on game animals. No repeat guests, please - each guest must be 'new blood' in an effort to expose our club to hunters who have never experienced High Pine.

Deer Management

- High Pine's standard for harvesting a buck is 8 points or better and beyond the ears. The expectation is that all members are making a conscious decision to properly manage the herd and allow the younger bucks to grow to their **full potential**. Your second buck should be bigger than your first. **No mount, NO SHOOT!**
- Each animal that is harvested must be recorded in a journal kept by High Pine. Each hunter is responsible for **reporting to management each kill prior to field dressing**.
- Beginning gun season, specific hunting areas/stands will be designated for BUCKS ONLY. These designated stands will be posted by High Pine management.
- Does - Must weigh 75lbs. or more.

Penalties

- **DOES:** Any member in violation of shooting an immature doe or yearling weighing less than 75 lbs. will forfeit **two (2) doe tags and be fined \$250**. A second violation will result in forfeiting **two (2) additional doe tags plus a \$500 fine**. **THINK BEFORE YOU SHOOT.**
- **BUCKS:** **ANY VIOLATION OF HIGH PINE'S DEER MANAGEMENT POLICY WILL RESULT IN A \$750 FINE. SUBSEQUENT VIOLATIONS COULD RESULT IN MEMBERSHIP SUSPENSION OR DISMISSAL FROM CLUB. MEMBER WILL BE SENT AN INVOICE REGARDING ANY VIOLATION. NO DISCUSSION NEEDED. IF THERE IS A QUESTION ABOUT WHETHER OR NOT A DEER SHOULD HAVE BEEN SHOT, IT SHOULD NOT HAVE BEEN SHOT.**
- **Wounded deer**, buck or doe, will count as a kill. **If there's blood, it's wounded.**

**** All money collected from fines is used for the improvement of High Pine Hunting Club.**

General Club Rules

- All properties will have stand check-in boards (DEER AND TURKEY). **Each hunter is required to check IN and OUT of the stand they are hunting.** Magnets will be provided to each hunter and MUST BE USED on the boards for deer hunting. Reserving a stand the night prior to a hunt is prohibited. A.M. stands are first come, first served. **Only ONE stand may be reserved at a time.** *Please remember to check OUT after your hunt! Hunter is allowed to reserve a PM stand in the AM (same day). It is NOT necessary to coordinate your deer hunt with Randy unless there are special circumstances. *The check-in boards suffice.*
- **ALL TURKEY HUNTS MUST BE COORDINATED THROUGH RANDY.**
- **ALCOHOL: IF YOU ARE CONSUMING ALCOHOL DURING THE DAY, YOU MAY NOT HUNT AFTERWARD.** This rule is in place for both safety and liability reasons, and to set a good example for other hunters, especially youth hunters. Please respect this policy for the safety of fellow members and the protection of the club.
- **FIELD CAMERAS: Each membership will be limited to a maximum of four (4) cameras.**
- No trucks, UTVs or ATVs are permitted on any food plots. The only exception will be for the retrieval of a harvested animal. Under these circumstances *only* will it be allowed, and the hunter must keep to the edge of the field to limit the damage to any planted crop.
- **FEEDING DEER:** A limited amount of corn is provided by High Pine each season. Additional corn is the responsibility of members. High Pine will continue to fill club feeders and plant/maintain food plots; however, **High Pine is NOT obligated to put out corn in front of stands and/or cameras for individuals.**
- **Do not put corn in food plots.**
- **Club ATV's:** ATV use is **not included** as part of your club membership and should not be considered a perk or service. ATV loans will remain occasional and at the discretion of club management.

- ONLY High Pine club members and their **approved** guests will be allowed on any High Pine property or properties leased by High Pine.
- Members/guests are prohibited from crossing over any boundaries for any reason without permission of High Pine management.
- All hunters must abide by any and all signs posted on properties.
- **WEAPONS:** GUNS are **NOT ALLOWED** on lodge premises except for gun range, your vehicle, or your bedroom (IN A CASE). Guns must **ALWAYS be UNLOADED** until ready to hunt. Safety must ALWAYS be ON until READY TO SHOOT. ALWAYS CHECK YOUR WEAPONS. **Failure to comply could result in club dismissal.**
- **All members** and guests are expected to *clean up* after themselves while on club property. This includes properly disposing of trash, cleaning grilling areas after use, keeping Spike's in order, leaving lodging areas as you found them (please don't leave dishes for someone else to wash and put away!). Shell casings, clay debris and paper targets should be picked up and disposed of properly. In addition, please respect the land and all hunting areas, making sure to leave stands clean and free of any debris.
- **DONATIONS:** We always appreciate donations of supplies! High Pine is not required to maintain supplies for outdoor gatherings. Throughout deer season, we are constantly in need of **cooking oil, paper products, condiments, coffee, etc.** High Pine is not obligated to provide food for everyone at these gatherings. All participating members are expected to contribute equally.
- **Lodging:** **ALL ROOMS MUST BE BOOKED THROUGH BEVERLY. Please call or text 770-337-8934. Rooms may NOT be reserved via email.**
- **LINENS AND TOWELS:** All overnight members are asked to bring their own linens and towels. Sheets and pillow cases OR sleeping bags MUST BE used on beds - no exceptions. *Members who would like to use High Pine bed linens and sheets (beds made) will be charged standard guest fees + \$25 cleaning fee (see below). Please notify management prior to your visit if you want this service.*
- **Check-in 2:00 PM. Check-out 10:00 AM.** **You are welcome to stay and hunt on your departure day but please clear your room by 10!*
- **Reduced Lodging Rates (members):** **Main Lodge - \$60 per room/per night. \$70 for Willow Suite with daybed** if daybed is used. **Bunkhouse** - Bunkhouse (single rooms) is used for *overflow lodging only*, when main lodge is full. Under these circumstances only, rooms are **\$60 per night/per room**. Otherwise, bunkhouse can be rented to any member on a nightly basis for **\$175 per night**.
- Lodging **MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO DEPARTURE**. If money is left at lodge, please inform management. Forms of payment: Credit cards (3.5% processing fee), Zelle, cash and checks. *We no longer take Venmo. We do not invoice for lodging.*
- 2 guests per room max. (Willow Suite with daybed: 3 guests per room max.)

- Please confirm your lodging dates and **keep changes to a MINIMUM**. BE SURE of the dates prior to booking. If you must make changes or cancel, please call Beverly as soon as possible. In the past, members have been denied lodging only to learn that someone canceled at the last minute or just didn't show up. **BE RESPECTFUL OF YOUR FELLOW MEMBERS.**

- **All** turkey hunts must be coordinated through Randy. In addition, *it is mandatory that hunters check in and out promptly*. Check-in stations are provided.

A VALID GEORGIA HUNTING LICENSE IS REQUIRED FOR ALL HUNTING INCLUDING PREDATOR HUNTING.

YOUTH HUNTING: Ages 11 and under cannot hunt alone and **MUST BE UNDER DIRECT SUPERVISION** of a licensed adult (18 or older) **AT ALL TIMES.**

AGES 12 to 15 must complete a hunter safety education course to hunt on their own. If they have not taken the course, they are legally required to be under direct supervision of a licensed adult.
